PRIVACY POLICY

San Francisco de los Romo, Aguascalientes, is responsible for collecting your personal data, the use given to them and their protection. All this information is treated according to the Federal Law on the Protection of Personal Data (LFPDP) in Possession of Private Parties, always guaranteeing its confidentiality.

All customer information is used for identification purposes, internal analysis within the testing process, provision of our commercial services, for administrative activities as part of the same process, for the purposes of communication with customers and interested parties or any other similar activity in accordance with its corporate purpose of the testing laboratory.

The Personal Data that you freely and voluntarily provide to the PRUCER Laboratory directly or by the means available to the parties (printed or electronic document, telephone and/or electronic means), as well as any other information that we obtain from legally available public sources or by any other means, may include, but is not limited to, a name, address, email address, phone numbers, etc. By virtue of the above, by providing your personal data, you agree that the PRUCER Laboratory will handle them exclusively for the purpose required by the testing services process.

If necessary, we may share information to meet requests from the authorities or to protect and defend the rights of Laboratorio PRUCER, always in accordance with the provisions of the Federal Law on Protection of Personal Data in Possession of Private Parties.

Any client has the right to access and rectify the personal data we have, as well as to oppose the processing of the same or revoke the consent that they have granted us for this purpose, and for this purpose they can contact the Staff of the PRUCER Laboratory. At any time, the client may request in writing to the PRUCER Laboratory that their personal data not be disclosed, in particular when they consider that they are not being used for the purposes consented to or the commercial or service relationship has ended. These rights are called **ARCO rights**.

In terms of the provisions of the Law, these rights may be exercised as **of January 15, 2020**. The PRUCER Laboratory reserves the right to change this privacy notice at any time, in which case, a visible note will be published on the company's website or the interested parties will be notified by the means accessible to the parties.
